9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.2, as
11 amended by Section 7, Chapter 397, O.S.L. 2015 (74 O.S. Supp. 2016,
12 Section 150.2), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 150.2. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall
14 have the power and duty to:

15 1. Maintain a nationally accredited scientific laboratory to
16 assist all law enforcement agencies in the discovery and detection
17 of criminal activity;

18 2. Maintain fingerprint and other identification files
19 including criminal history records, juvenile identification files,
20 and DNA profiles;

21 3. Establish, coordinate and maintain the automated
22 fingerprinting identification system (AFIS) and the deoxyribonucleic
23 acid (DNA) laboratory;

- 1 4. Operate teletype, mobile and fixed radio or other
2 communications systems;
- 3 5. Conduct schools and training programs for the agents, peace
4 officers, and technicians of this state charged with the enforcement
5 of law and order and the investigation and detection of crime;
- 6 6. Assist the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of
7 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Chief Medical Examiner,
8 and all law enforcement officers and district attorneys when such
9 assistance is requested, in accordance with the policy determined by
10 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation Commission established in
11 Section 150.3 of this title;
- 12 7. Investigate and detect criminal activity when directed to do
13 so by the Governor;
- 14 8. Investigate, detect, institute and maintain actions
15 involving vehicle theft pursuant to Section 150.7a of this title or
16 oil, gas or oil field equipment theft pursuant to Sections 152.2
17 through 152.9 of this title;
- 18 9. Investigate any criminal threat made to the physical safety
19 of elected or appointed officials of this state or any political
20 subdivision of the state and forward the results of that
21 investigation to the Department of Public Safety, and provide
22 security to foreign elected or appointed officials while they are in
23 this state on official business;
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1 10. Investigate and detect violations of the Oklahoma Computer
2 Crimes Act; and

3 11. Investigate and enforce all laws relating to any crime
4 listed in Section 571 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes that
5 occur on the turnpikes; and

6 12. Have original jurisdiction to investigate all deaths of
7 incarcerated offenders when the death occurs in any jail in the
8 state or in the Oklahoma prison system.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
