15	Section 375.5. The Oklahoma Durable Medical Equipment Licensing

  - a. the durable medical equipment is limited to prescription-required specialty devices that are delivered directly to the patient's home, and
  - b. the initial order for the prescribed product is delivered by an Oklahoma licensed practitioner directly to the patient's home for setup and training;

- $\frac{11.}{12.}$  Suppliers of medical devices approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration that are used in the treatment of cancerous tumors.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
