11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 199.1, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 199.1. As used in the Oklahoma Cosmetology and
14	Barbering Act:
15	1. "Apprentice" means a person who is engaged in learning the
16	practice of cosmetology or barbering in a cosmetology or barbering
17	establishment;
18	2. "Barber" or "barber stylist" means any person who engages in
19	the practice of barbering;
20	3. "Barbering" means any one or any combination of the
21	following practices, when done upon the upper part of the human body
22	for cosmetic purposes and when done for payment either directly or
23	indirectly for the general public, constitutes constitute the
24	practice of barbering, to wit: Shaving or trimming the beard or

1 cutting the hair; giving facial or scalp massages or treatment with 2 oils, creams, lotions or other preparations, either by hand or 3 mechanical appliances; singeing, shampooing or applying lighteners 4 or color to the hair or applying hair tonics; applying cosmetic 5 preparations, antiseptics, powders, oils, clays or lotions to scalp, 6 face, neck or upper part of the body; and removing superfluous hair 7 from the face, neck or upper part of the body;

8 4. "Barber establishment" means an establishment or place of
9 business where one or more persons are engaged in the practice of
10 barbering, but shall not include barber schools or colleges;

5. "Barber school" or "barber college" means an establishment
operated for the purpose of teaching barbering;

6. "Blow-dry styling" means the practice of shampooing, 13 conditioning, drying, arranging, curling, straightening, or styling 14 hair using mechanical devices, hairsprays, and topical agents 15 including, but not limited to, balms, oils, and serums. Blow-dry 16 styling shall include the use and styling of hair extensions, hair 17 pieces, and wigs. Blow-dry styling shall not include cutting hair 18 or the application of dyes, bleach, reactive chemicals, keratin 19 treatments, or other preparations for the coloring and altering of 20 hair structure. Individuals solely practicing blow-dry styling as 21 defined in this paragraph shall not be required to hold a license or 22 certification under the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act; 23 7. "Board" means the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering; 24

8. 9. "Cosmetician" means a person licensed by the Board to
perform patron services limited to hair arranging and the
application of makeup, including, but not limited to, using
hairstyling tools and products. Services must be performed in a
licensed establishment;

9 9. 10. "Cosmetology" means any one or combination of practices generally and usually performed by and known as the occupation of 10 beauticians, beauty culturists, beauty operators, cosmeticians, 11 12 cosmetologists, or hairdressers or of any other person holding himself or herself out as practicing cosmetology by whatever 13 designation and within the meaning of the Oklahoma Cosmetology and 14 Barbering Act and in or upon whatever place or premises. 15 Cosmetology shall include, but not be limited to, any one or 16 combination of the following practices: bleaching, cleansing, 17 curling, cutting, coloring, dressing, removing, singeing, styling, 18 waving, or similar work upon the hair of any person by any means, 19 whether with hands or mechanical or electrical apparatus or 20 appliances. Nothing in the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act 21 shall be construed to prohibit the use of hands or mechanical or 22 electrical apparatus or appliances for the nonpermanent removal of 23 hair from the human body without puncturing of the skin or the use 24

7 10. <u>11.</u> "Cosmetology establishment" means an establishment or 8 place of business where one or more persons are engaged in the 9 practices of cosmetology but shall not include cosmetology schools 10 or colleges;

11. 12. "Cosmetology or barber school/college" means any place 11 12 or premises where instruction in any or all the practices of cosmetology or barbering is given. Any person, firm, institution or 13 corporation, who holds himself, herself or itself out as a school to 14 teach and train, or any person, firm, institution or corporation who 15 shall teach and train any other person or persons in any of the 16 practices of cosmetology or barbering is hereby declared to be 17 engaged in operating a cosmetology and/or barber school, and shall 18 be subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Cosmetology and 19 Barbering Act. Licensed cosmetology and/or barber schools may offer 20 education to secondary and postsecondary students in this state; 21 12. 13. "Demonstrator" means a person who is not licensed in 22 this state as an operator or instructor and who demonstrates any 23 24 cosmetic preparation. The person shall be required to obtain a

Demonstrator license and pass a state written exam relating to general safety and sanitation from the Board before making any such demonstrations;

4 13. 14. "Facial/Esthetics instructor" means a person licensed
5 by the Board as a qualified teacher of the art and science of facial
6 and esthetics theory and practice;

7 14. 15. "Facialist/Esthetician" means any person who gives
8 facials for compensation;

9 15. 16. "Hairbraiding technician" means a person certified by 10 the Board to perform hairbraiding, hairweaving techniques, and hair 11 extensions in a licensed cosmetology establishment;

12 16. <u>17.</u> "Hybrid learning" means courses that combine face-to-13 face classroom instruction with on-line <u>online</u>, computer-based 14 learning;

15 <u>17.</u> <u>18.</u> "Manicurist/Nail technician" means a person who gives 16 manicures, gives pedicures, or applies artificial nails;

17 18. 19. "Manicurist/Nail technician instructor" means a person 18 licensed by the Board as a qualified teacher of the art and science 19 of nail technology theory and practice;

20 <u>19.</u> "Master barber instructor" means a person who gives 21 instruction in barbering or any practices thereof;

22 20. <u>21.</u> "Master cosmetology instructor" means a person who 23 gives instruction in cosmetology or any practices thereof;

1 <u>21. 22.</u> "Postsecondary institution" means a school licensed to 2 teach students according to prescribed curriculum as in paragraph 1 3 of subsection G of Section 199.7 of this title and in Board rule 4 175:10-3-34(a);

5 <u>22.</u> <u>23.</u> "Public school" means any state-supported institution 6 conducting a cosmetology program;

7 23. 24. "Secondary institution" means a school licensed to 8 teach students eligible for credit of five hundred (500) hours of 9 related subjects as prescribed in paragraph 2 of subsection G of 10 Section 199.7 of this title and in Board rule 175:10-3-34(b); and

11 24. 25. "Student" means a person who is enrolled in and 12 attending a cosmetology or barbering school for the purpose of 13 learning the practice of cosmetology or barbering.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
