13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 43, Chapter 366, O.S.L.
14	2016 (37A O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 2-131), is amended to read as
15	follows:
16	Section 2-131. A. A small farm winery license shall authorize
17	the holder thereof:
18	1. To manufacture and bottle wines produced by that small farm
19	winery; and
20	2. To bottle and sell wines produced by another small farm
21	winery. In order for a small farm winery to bottle and sell another
22	small farm winery's products, both the selling winery and the buying
23	winery shall be small farm winery permit holders <u>;</u>

1	3. To serve free samples of wine produced by the licensee to
2	visitors twenty-one (21) years of age or older;
3	4. To sell wines produced by that small farm winery for either
4	on-premises or off-premises consumption to consumers on the small
5	farm winery premises, or premises located contiguous thereto;
6	5. To sell wine at public events such as trade shows or
7	festivals; and
8	6. To also hold a mixed beverage license, beer and wine license
9	or caterer's license.
10	B. A small farm wine may display the trademarked "Oklahoma
11	Grown" sticker available from the Oklahoma Grape Industry Council.
12	C. For purposes of subsection A of this section, no visitor may
13	sample more than a total of six (6) fluid ounces of wine per day.
14	The small farm winery shall restrict the distribution and
15	consumption of wine samples to an area within the licensed premises
16	designated by the small farm winery. A current floor plan that
17	includes the designated sampling area must be on file with the ABLE
18	Commission. No visitor under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be
19	permitted to enter this designated sampling area when samples are
20	being distributed or consumed. Samples of wine served by a small
21	farm winery under this section shall not be considered a sale of
22	wine within the meaning of Article XXVIIIA of the Oklahoma
23	Constitution or Section 1-103 of this title; however, such samples
24	of wine shall be considered wine removed or withdrawn from the small

1	farm winery for use or consumption for excise tax determination and
2	reporting requirements.
