11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1097 of Title 22, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Persons convicted in this state, who make a request for transfer
16 to another state pursuant to the Interstate Compact as prescribed in
17 Section 1093 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall pay a
18 transfer application fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each
19 transfer application submitted. The transfer application fee shall
20 be paid to the Department of Corrections upon submission of the
21 transfer application. The Director of the Department or the
22 Director's designee may waive the application fee if it is
23 determined that the payment of the fee will constitute an undue
24 economic burden on the offender. All fees collected pursuant to

1 this section shall be deposited into the Department of Corrections
2 Revolving Fund.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
