An Act relating to swine; making it unlawful to import or possess exotic swine; authorizing the State Veterinarian to grant exceptions for zoos; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Exotic Swine

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-6 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. It shall be unlawful and be a misdemeanor in Oklahoma to import or possess exotic swine of the family Suidae. Provided, however, exotic swine species shall not include pot-bellied pigs, teacup pigs and other swine or pigs commonly owned as domestic pets.
- B. The State Veterinarian may grant exceptions for importation and possession by a zoo accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
