13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 12A O.S. 2011, Section 4A-108, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 4A-108. EXCLUSION OF CONSUMER TRANSACTIONS GOVERNED BY
16	FEDERAL LAW
17	RELATIONSHIP TO ELECTRONIC FUND TRANSFER ACT
18	A. This Except as provided in subsection B of this section,
19	this Article does not apply to a funds transfer any part of which is
20	governed by the Electronic Fund Transfer Act of 1978 (Title XX,
21	Public Law 95-630, 92 Stat. 3728, 15 U.S.C. Section 1693 et seq.) as
22	amended from time to time.
23	B. This Article applies to a funds transfer that is a
24	remittance transfer as defined in the Electronic Fund Transfer Act

1	(15 U.S.C. Sec. 1693o-1) as amended from time to time, unless the
2	remittance transfer is an electronic fund transfer as defined in the
3	Electronic Fund Transfer Act (15 U.S.C. Sec. 1693a) as amended from
4	time to time.
5	C. In a funds transfer to which this Article applies, in the
6	event of an inconsistency between an applicable provision of this
7	Article and an applicable provision of the Electronic Fund Transfer
8	Act, the provision of the Electronic Fund Transfer Act governs to
9	the extent of the inconsistency.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
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
