An Act relating to definitions and general provisions; creating A Day of Remembrance; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Creating A Day of Remembrance

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 90.23 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The second Saturday of December of each year is hereby designated as "A Day of Remembrance", and the Governor is authorized and requested to issue a proclamation commemorating the day and honoring soldiers buried at the Fort Gibson National Cemetery and the Fort Sill National Cemetery. On or before the second Saturday in December, holiday wreaths will be placed on the graves of those soldiers in remembrance of their service and to show respect during the holiday season.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
