BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1151.2, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 270, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1151.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1151.2. As used in the Roofing Contractor Registration Act:

1. "Advertise" means any written publication, dissemination, solicitation, contract, bid, promotional item, or circulation which is intended to directly or indirectly induce any person to contract for roofing construction services with the advertiser, including, but not limited to, business cards, telephone directory display advertisements, vehicle signage, radio, television and electronic solicitations;

2. "Applicant" means the qualifying party, or if no qualifying party, any person applying under the Roofing Contractor Registration

Act for a roofing contractor registration to be issued by the
 Construction Industries Board;

3. "Board" means the Construction Industries Board;
4. "Committee" means the Committee of Roofing Examiners;
5. "Homeowner" means one who owns and resides in, or who
6 resides in, or who contracts for the purchase, construction,
7 remodeling or repairing of a residence;

8 6. "Nonresident contractor" means any contractor who has not 9 established and maintained a place of business as a roofing 10 contractor in this state within the preceding year, or who claims 11 residency in another state, or who has not submitted an income tax 12 return as a resident of this state within the preceding year;

13 7. "Owner" means person who owns the property or is a lessee of 14 the property;

8. "Person" means any natural person, firm, limited or general partnership, corporation, association, limited liability company, trust, association, other legal entity and any organization capable of conducting business, or any combination thereof acting as a unit, unless the intent to give a more limited meaning is disclosed clearly by the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

9. "Prime contractor" means a general contractor, commercial
contractor, or other contractor who contracts directly with the
owner for construction trade work in multiple trade areas;

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1 10. "Project manager" means one who manages construction
 2 projects consisting of work involving multiple trades;

"Public contract" means a contract with the State of 3 11. Oklahoma, its political subdivisions, or any board, commission, or 4 5 department thereof, or with any board of county commissioners, or with any city council, school board, or with any state or municipal 6 7 agency, or with any other public board, body, commission, or agency authorized to award contracts for the construction or reconstruction 8 9 of public works and includes subcontracts undertaken to perform 10 works covered by the original contract or any part thereof;

12. "Qualifying party" means a natural person who is an officer 12 or owner of the corporation, a member of the limited liability 13 company, or a general partner of the limited liability partnership, 14 and who is actively engaged in the work undertaken by the registrant 15 for which a registration is required pursuant to the Roofing 16 Contractor Registration Act who meets the experience and ability 17 requirements for registration on behalf of the registrant;

18 13. "Registrar" means the Construction Industries Board or any 19 person designated by the Board to administer the provisions of the 20 Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

21 14. "Registration" means the process of applying for an initial 22 or renewal registration which upon approval is exhibited by a 23 registration number and card issued pursuant to the Roofing 24 Contractor Registration Act;

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1 15. "Registration number" means the roofing registration number
 2 issued by the registrar to the registrant's qualifying party;

3 16. "Registrant" means a holder of a registration issued4 pursuant to the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

5 17. "Residence" means a single structure for residential occupancy or use which is a detached one- to four-family dwelling or 6 a multiple single-family dwelling (townhouse) not more than three 7 stories/floors above grade plane in height with a separate means of 8 9 egress, and any appurtenances thereto, which is intended for use as 10 a primary habitation and is in compliance with the International 11 Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code 12 Commission:

18. "Roofing contractor" means any person, including a 13 subcontractor and nonresident contractor, engaged in the business of 14 commercial or residential roofing contractor work, or who himself or 15 herself, or through another, attempts to or advertises, holds 16 himself or herself out as having, or purports to have, the capacity 17 to undertake roofing contractor work, or offers to engage in or 18 solicits roofing installation-related services, including 19 construction, installation, renovation, remodeling, reroofing, 20 repair, maintenance, alteration, and waterproofing, unless 21 specifically exempted in the Roofing Contractor Registration Act. 22 Roofing contractor shall not mean: 23

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- a. a person engaged in the demolition of a structure or
   the cleanup of construction waste and debris that
   contains roofing material,
- b. a person working under the direct supervision of the
  roofing contractor who is hired either as an employee,
  day laborer, or contract laborer whose payment,
  received in any form, from the roofing contractor is
  subject to self-employment tax,
- 9 c. a person working on his or her own property or that of 10 an immediate relative and such person is not receiving 11 any compensation, or
- d. a person acting as a handyman who is receiving
  compensation from the property owner and who is
  performing the roofing repair in conjunction with
  other repairs to the property and who does not perform
  more than two roofing jobs per year;

19. "Roofing contractor work" means the installation, 17 fabrication or assembly of equipment or systems included in roofing 18 systems as defined in the International Building Code and the 19 International Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform 20 Building Code Commission, and which codes are hereby adopted and 21 incorporated by reference. Roofing construction work includes, but 22 is not limited to, installation, renovation, remodeling, reroofing, 23 reconstructing, repair, maintenance, improvement, alteration, and 24

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waterproofing, unless specifically exempted in the Roofing
 Contractor Registration Act.

- "Commercial roofing contractor work" means work done 3 a. on commercial, industrial or public building roofing 4 5 systems or structures as defined in the International Building Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform 6 Building Code Commission; except it does not mean 7 buildings used for commercial purposes having 8 9 equivalent or substantially the same roofing 10 requirements as a "residence" defined herein, 11 including but not limited to business offices 12 converted from a structure that formerly was a 13 residence, and
- "Residential roofing contractor work" means work done b. 14 15 on roofing systems as defined in the International Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform 16 Building Code Commission, or as defined as a 17 "residence" herein; except for buildings used for 18 commercial purposes having equivalent or substantially 19 the same roofing requirements as a "residence" defined 20 herein, including but not limited to business offices 21 converted from a structure that formerly was a 22 23 residence;
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20. "Roofing Hearing Board" means the Roofing Hearing Board
 which shall consist of a designee of the Construction Industries
 Board, as chair, and the members of the Committee of Roofing
 Examiners;

Subcontractor" means one who contracts with a prime
contractor, general contractor, residential contractor, project
manager, property manager, another subcontractor, or another entity
for roofing contractor work. Subcontractor shall not mean a laboronly subcontractor working under the supervision of a registered and

## 10 endorsed roofing contractor or roofing subcontractor;

11 22. "Variance" means the use of an alternative material or 12 method of construction from that prescribed in the International 13 Building Code or the International Residential Code or other 14 approved documents by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission 15 for use at a particular location or project specified in the 16 variance application; and

17 23. "Variance and Appeals Board" means the Oklahoma State18 Roofing Installation Code Variance and Appeals Board.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
