7	An Act relating to public finance; requiring the
8	Office of Management and Enterprise Services to initiate a request for proposal for ongoing
9	maintenance of desktop support systems; authorizing the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to
10	enter into a contract for such services; establishing certain requirements for the request for proposal;
11	establishing that contract shall be awarded to an offeror who can guarantee savings; requiring
12	promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.203 of Title 62, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. By July 1, 2020, the Director of the Office of Management
20	and Enterprise Services shall initiate a request for proposal for
21	the ongoing maintenance of desktop support and management systems
22	for all state agencies. The Office of Management and Enterprise
23	Services is authorized to enter into a contract for such services,
24 2 7	pursuant to the provisions of law.

1	B. Notice of the request for proposal shall be published in the
2	manner provided for competitive bidding. The requests for proposal
3	must solicit quotations and must specify the importance of
4	guaranteed savings, price, quality, technical ability and
5	experience. The contract shall be awarded to the responsible
6	offeror whose proposal is determined to achieve guaranteed savings
7	to this state in comparison with the cost of current of desktop
8	support and management as provided by the Information Services
9	Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
10	C. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
11	Services shall promulgate rules and establish procedures to
12	implement the request for proposal pursuant to this section.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
