Should any railroad, air carrier, or public 14 service corporation doing business in this state fail or refuse to 15 file the statements or schedules with the Oklahoma Tax Commission 16 within the time and manner required by law, it shall be the duty of 17 the State Board of Equalization to ascertain from the best 18 information obtainable the value of the property of such company. 19 The Tax Commission may grant an extension without penalty, upon 20 written request of the taxpayer and for a good cause, of not to 21 exceed fifteen (15) days for the filing of the returns as required 22 by the Ad Valorem Tax Code. 23 24
