7 An Act relating to drones; defining term; providing
8 civil immunity for damage or destruction to certain
9 property under certain circumstances; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 80.1 of Title 76, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. As used in this section, "drone" means a powered, aerial
16 vehicle that carries or is equipped with a recording device that
17 does not carry a human operator, uses aerodynamic forces to provide
18 vehicle lift and can fly autonomously or be piloted remotely. A
19 drone may be expendable or recoverable.

20 B. Any person owning or controlling real estate or other
21 premises who voluntarily damages or destroys a drone located on the
22 real estate or premises or within the airspace of the real estate or
23 premises not otherwise regulated by the Federal Aviation
24 Administration **or where a reasonable expectation of privacy exists,**

1 shall, together with any successors in interest, if any, not be
2 civilly liable for causing the damage or destruction to the property
3 of such person.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
