- 2. Pay for gifts or incentives offered to a student or his or her parent or legal guardian to enroll in the public school district, charter school or virtual charter school; or
- 3. Provide financial incentives to a school employee for the recruitment of students from a school, charter school or virtual charter school at which the employee was previously employed.
- B. The Statewide Virtual Charter School Board and the State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
