4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as 6 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp. 7 2017, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

8 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby 9 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license 10 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or 11 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other 12 subject as provided by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

1 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept applications for special license plates authorized under this 3 4 The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's section. 5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 6 7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 8 9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 14 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 15 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 16 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 17 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 18 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 19 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 20 removed from the vehicle.

Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
License plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
License plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications

therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

7 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
8 follows:

9 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be 10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for 11 round and square dancing;

 License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

16 3. National Rifle Association License Plate - such plates shall
17 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
18 Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
19 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
20 Association;

4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated

carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
 contain the Masonic emblem;

5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
contain the Shriner's emblem;

14 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
15 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
16 ballooning in this state;

17 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall 18 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member 19 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an 20 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a 21 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an 22 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an 23 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate 24 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate

shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

3 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be 4 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of 5 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 6 7 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights 8 9 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the 10 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation 11 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of 12 Columbus emblem;

9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

17 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
19 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
20 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with Kiwanis International;

22 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
24 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified

Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public Accountants;

6 Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates 12. 7 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons 8 9 applying for such license plate must show proof of official 10 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment, 11 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or 12 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state 13 emergency management department head;

14 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
16 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
17 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
18 Conservation Corps;

19 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and 20 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian 21 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license 22 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton 23 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the 24 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate

6 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and
7 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
8 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

9 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be 10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for 11 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued 12 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to 13 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate 14 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

15 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be 16 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, 17 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this 18 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons 19 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon 20 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club. 21 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of 22 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 23 personalized license plates;

The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar 22 design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space 23 requirements of a motorcycle license plate; and

2	plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
3	the Daughters of the American Revolution for a vehicle or motorcycle

20SECTION 2.AMENDATORY47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as21last amended by Section 1, Chapter 339, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.222017, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license

plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other

 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.

9 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.30 of Title 47, unless 11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section 13 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Down Syndrome 14 Association of Central Oklahoma license plates shall be deposited to 15 the Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate 16 Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

17 Β. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 18 fund for the State Department of Human Services to be designated the 19 "Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate 20 Revolving Fund". The fund shall consist of all monies received 21 pursuant to subsection A of this section. Educators License Plate shall be deposited in the Extraordinary
Educators License Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of
this section.

11 Β. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 12 fund for the State Department of Education to be designated the 13 "Extraordinary Educators License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund 14 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, 15 and shall consist of all monies received by the Department pursuant 16 to the provisions of subsection A of this section. All monies 17 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may 18 be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose of 19 providing grants to school superintendents for distribution to 20 educators who propose extraordinary activities, projects or lessons 21 for students from kindergarten through eighth grade. Expenditures 22 from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State 23 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
