9 Β. 1. When determining the Minimum Salary Schedule, "fringe benefits" shall mean all or part of retirement benefits, excluding 10 the contributions made pursuant to subsection A of Section 17-108.1 11 of this title and the flexible benefit allowance pursuant to Section 12 13 26-105 of this title from the flexible benefit allowance funds disbursed by the State Board of Education and the State Board of 14 Career and Technology Education pursuant to Section 26-104 of this 15 title. 16

17 2. If a school district intends to provide retirement benefits 18 to a teacher such that the teacher's salary would be less than the 19 amounts set forth in the minimum salary schedule specified in 20 subsection A of this section, the district shall be required to 21 provide written notification to the teacher prior to his or her 22 employment or, if already employed by the district, no later than 23 thirty (30) days prior to the date the district elects to provide

retirement benefits such that the teacher's salary would be less
 than the minimum salary schedule.

C. Any of the degrees referred to in this section shall be from 3 a college recognized by the State Board of Education. 4 The Board 5 shall accept teaching experience from out-of-state school districts that are accredited by the state board of education or appropriate 6 state accrediting agency for the districts. The Board shall accept 7 teaching experience from out-of-country schools that are accredited 8 9 or otherwise endorsed by the appropriate national or regional accrediting or endorsement authority. Out-of-country certification 10 documentation in a language other than English shall be analyzed by 11 an educational credential evaluation service in accordance with 12 13 industry standards and guidelines and approved by the State Department of Education. The person seeking to have credit granted 14 for out-of-country teaching experience shall be responsible for all 15 costs of the analysis by a credential evaluation service. The Board 16 17 shall accept teaching experience from primary and secondary schools that are operated by the United States Department of Defense or are 18 affiliated with the United States Department of State. 19

D. <u>1.</u> For the purpose of state salary increments and retirement, no teacher shall be granted credit for more than five (5) years of active duty in the military service or out-of-state or out-of-country teaching experience as a certified teacher or its equivalent.

<u>2. For the purpose of state salary increments, no teacher shall</u>
 <u>be granted credit for more than ten (10) years of active duty in the</u>
 <u>military service. For the purposes of retirement, no teacher shall</u>
 <u>be granted credit for more than five (5) years of active duty in the</u>
 <u>military service.</u>

Nothing in this section shall prohibit boards of education from
crediting more years of experience on district salary schedules than
those allowed for state purposes.

9 E. The State Board of Education shall recognize, for purposes 10 of certification and salary increments, all the years of experience 11 of a:

Certified teacher who teaches in the educational program of
 the Department of Corrections, beginning with fiscal year 1981;

14 2. Vocational rehabilitation counselor under the Department of
15 Human Services if the counselor was employed as a certified teacher
16 by the State Department of Education when the Division of Vocational
17 Rehabilitation was transferred from the State Board of Career and
18 Technology Education or the State Board of Education to the Oklahoma
19 Public Welfare Commission on July 1, 1968;

3. Vocational rehabilitation counselor which were completed
 while employed by the Department of Human Services if such counselor
 was certified as a teacher or was eligible for certification as a
 teacher in Oklahoma;

4. Certified teacher which were completed while employed by the
 Child Study Center located at University Hospital, if the teacher
 was certified as a teacher in Oklahoma; and

5. Certified school psychologist or psychometrist which were
completed while employed as a doctoral intern, psychological
assistant, or psychologist with any agency of the State of Oklahoma
this state if the experience primarily involved work with persons of
school- or preschool-age and if the person was, at the time the
experience was acquired, certified as, or eligible for certification
as, a school psychologist or psychometrist.

F. The provisions of this section shall not apply to teachers who have entered into postretirement employment with a public school in Oklahoma and are still receiving a monthly retirement benefit.

If a person employed as certified personnel, as defined in G. 14 Section 26-103 of this title, by a school district during the 2017-15 2018 school year was receiving a salary above the step level 16 17 indicated by the State Minimum Salary Schedule for the 2017-2018 school year, the person shall receive a salary increase amount equal 18 to the amount indicated in subsection A for the step level indicated 19 for the person, provided they remain employed by the same district, 20 unless the hours or the duties of the certified personnel are 21 reduced proportionately. 22

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
