11	branch and state's law enforcement.

13	WHEREAS, the U.S. Congress has not formerly declared war as
14	required by the U.S. Constitution regarding the Russian-Ukrainian
15	conflict; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the nation of Ukraine and the soldiers of the Ukrainian
	military are not members of NATO; and
18	WHEREAS, recent reports indicate the Ukrainian military launched
19	a rocket that landed in Poland, killing innocent Polish citizens,
20	and the citizens of Oklahoma need not be under threat of a similar
21	failure impacting our people; and
22	WHEREAS, the Pentagon recently announced their intent to send
23	approximately 100 members of the Ukrainian military into Oklahoma to
24 2 -	train on U.S. military rocket defenses.
