3 SENATE JOINT
4 RESOLUTION NO. 14

6 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
7 to refer to the people for their approval or
8 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of
9 Article VII-B of the Oklahoma Constitution;
10 increasing amount of votes necessary to retain
11 certain officers; providing ballot title; and
12 directing filing.

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
14 1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

15 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17 the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article VII-B of
18 the Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

19 Section 2. At the general election next before his term
20 expires, any Judicial Officer may seek retention in office by filing
21 with the Secretary of State, not less than sixty (60) days before
22 the date of such election, a declaration of candidacy to succeed
23 himself. Thereupon, at such election, there shall be submitted to
24 the qualified electors of the State, on a separate ballot, without
party designation, this question:

1 "Shall (Here insert name of Justice or Judge) of (Here
2 insert the title of the court) be retained in Office?

3 YES

4 NO

5 The question shall be decided by ~~a majority~~ sixty percent (60%)
6 of those voting thereon. If the decision is "yes" the Judicial
7 Officer shall be retained in office for the next ensuing six (6)
8 year term. If the decision is "no", or if no declaration of
9 candidacy is filed, the office shall be vacant upon expiration of
10 the term then being served, and the former Judicial Officer shall
11 not be eligible for appointment to succeed himself. Retention in
12 office may be sought for successive terms without limit as to
13 number, except for retirement as may be provided by the Legislature
14 for a maximum retirement age.

15 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
16 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
17 the following form:

19 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

20 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

21 This measure amends Section 2 of Article 7-B of the Oklahoma
22 Constitution. It increases to 60% the amount of votes needed to
23 retain a judge in office.

3 SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
4 immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file

7 General.
