House Bill 4123

Sponsored by Representative WITT; Representative FREDERICK (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish for every entering undergraduate class at each public university with governing board minimum percentage of students who must be Oregon residents.

Requires commission to develop standards to ensure university compliance with residency requirements and implementation plan for these standards by December 31, 2014.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Α	BILL	FOR	AN	ACT

- Relating to undergraduate composition at universities with a governing board; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2014 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 351.
 - SECTION 2. The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall:
 - (1) Establish for every entering undergraduate class at each public university with a governing board listed under ORS 352.054 the minimum percentage of students who must be Oregon residents; and
 - (2) Develop standards to ensure that each public university with a governing board meets the requirements set forth in subsection (1) of this section.
 - **SECTION 3. The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall:**
 - (1) Establish the undergraduate residency requirements and develop the standards required under section 2 of this 2014 Act by December 31, 2014;
 - (2) Develop, by December 31, 2014, a time frame for the public universities with governing boards listed under ORS 352.054 to implement the standards required under section 2 of this 2014 Act; and
 - (3) Submit a report detailing the commission's findings and standards established under section 2 of this 2014 Act to the committees relating to higher education during the 2015 regular session of the Legislative Assembly.
 - SECTION 4. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.
