## **House Concurrent Resolution 203**

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Recognizes and honors Deputy Thomas Robert Farrell (1939-1987) for his service to this state.

2	Whereas Deputy Thomas Robert Farrell was born on May 4, 1939, in Springfield, Missouri, to
3	James and Mildred Farrell and had six siblings; and
4	Whereas in 1957 Deputy Farrell graduated from Central High School in Springfield, Missouri
5	and
6	Whereas Deputy Farrell married Cathleen "Kay" A. Gauthier on June 13, 1959, and together
7	they had four children: Tammy Hulburt, Thomas R. Farrell II, Theresa Upton and Tracy Mellin; and
8	Whereas Deputy Farrell began his career of public service by serving his country for two years
9	in the United States Navy Reserve; and
10	Whereas Deputy Farrell served in the United States Air Force for 20 years, being stationed in
11	Mississippi, Pennsylvania, Maine, Oregon and Japan, with assignments in Korea, Vietnam and
12	Thailand; and
13	Whereas Deputy Farrell worked as a bartender, log truck driver and rural carrier for the United
14	States Postal Service before he began his work in law enforcement; and
15	Whereas Deputy Farrell began his law enforcement career as a Tillamook County Sheriff's Of
16	fice reserve deputy in September 1978 and served in that role until January 1984; and
17	Whereas Deputy Farrell furthered his career in law enforcement as a Tillamook County 9-1-
18	dispatcher from June 1979 to January 1984; and
19	Whereas Deputy Farrell became a deputy sheriff with the Tillamook County Sheriff's Office or
20	January 9, 1984; and
21	Whereas on April 22, 1987, after his 10-hour shift, Deputy Farrell was called upon by his deputy
22	trainee to assist with freeing a vehicle that had overturned in the surf on the beach in Tierra De
23	Mar, where Deputy Farrell suffered a fatal heart attack; and
24	Whereas Deputy Farrell was only 47 years old at the time of his death; and
25	Whereas Deputy Farrell loved to hunt and was passionate about fly fishing, enjoying tying his
26	own flies; and
27	Whereas Deputy Farrell was a caretaker for a 400-acre farm, where he raised beef cattle and
28	baled hay every summer; and
29	Whereas Deputy Farrell loved spending time with his family and friends, especially his grand
30	children; and

Whereas Deputy Farrell is described by loved ones as a compassionate, loving and caring man
