Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Fish and Wildlife; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:
