"Conspicuous." A term, written, displayed or presented in a 1 manner that a reasonable person against which the term is to 2 operate should have noticed. Conspicuous terms shall include the 3 following: 4 5 (1) A heading in capitals: 6 (i) greater in size than the surrounding text; and 7 (ii) in contrasting type, font or color to the surrounding text of lesser size. 8 9 (2) Language in the body of a record or display: (i) greater in size than the surrounding text; 10 11 (ii) in contrasting type or font to the surrounding 12 text of the same size; 13 (iii) in black type against a solid vellow 14 background; and (iv) set off from surrounding text of the same size 15 16 by symbols or other marks that call attention to the 17 language. * * * 18 19 Section 2. Section 343 of the act is amended to read: 20 Section 343. School district tax notices. Tax notice.--A school district that implements homestead 21 (a) 22 and farmstead exclusions shall itemize the homestead and 23 farmstead exclusion on tax bills sent to homestead and farmstead 24 owners, indicating the original amount of tax liability, the amount of the exclusion and the net amount of tax due after the 25 26 exclusion is applied. The tax bill shall be easily 27 understandable and include a notice pursuant to subsection (b).
