AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in lobbying disclosure, further
- providing for registration, for prohibited activities and for
- 4 penalties.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 13A04(a) of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes, amended February 14, 2018 (P.L.2, No.2),
- 9 is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
- 10 read:
- 11 § 13A04. Registration.
- 12 (a) General rule. -- Unless excluded under section 13A06
- 13 (relating to exemption from registration and reporting), and
- 14 <u>subject to the requirements under subsection (f)</u>, a lobbyist,
- 15 lobbying firm or a principal must register with the department
- 16 electronically using the computerized filing system developed by
- 17 the department that is consistent with the purposes of this
- 18 chapter within ten days of acting in any capacity as a lobbyist,

- 1 lobbying firm or principal. Registration shall be biennial and
- 2 shall begin January 1, 2007.
- 3 * * *
- 4 (f) Training requirements and documentation. -- The following
- 5 shall apply:
- 6 (1) An individual who is a lobbyist and an individual
- 7 <u>named on a principal's or lobbying firm's registration</u>
- 8 <u>statement under subsection (b)(1)(vii) must complete</u>
- 9 <u>training developed or approved by the department that</u>
- 10 addresses the restricted activities under section 1103(b)
- 11 <u>(relating to restricted activities), the prohibited</u>
- 12 <u>activities under section 13A07 (relating to prohibited</u>
- 13 <u>activities</u>) and the prevention of discrimination and
- 14 <u>harassment, including sexual harassment.</u>
- 15 (2) The department shall prescribe evidentiary
- 16 <u>documentation proving completion of the training required</u>
- 17 under paragraph (1), which must be submitted to the
- department within 30 days of the filing of the initial
- 19 <u>registration statement and at the time of filing a renewal</u>
- 20 registration statement.
- 21 (3) A lobbyist or lobbying firm may submit a request for
- 22 <u>approval by the department of training that meets the</u>
- 23 <u>requirements of paragraph (1). If the department does not</u>
- issue a response within 15 days of receipt of the request for
- 25 <u>approval, the request shall be deemed denied. The request for</u>
- approval does not toll the time for submittal of
- 27 <u>documentation evidencing completion of training under</u>
- paragraph (2).

13	(3.1) If the commission finds that a failure to complete
14	the training or submit the documentation required under
15	section 13A04(f) occurred, the commission shall determine the
16	amount of the administrative penalty to be imposed. The
17	administrative penalty shall not exceed \$1,000.

20	shall apply to an initial or biennial registration after the
21	effective date of this section.
22	Section 5. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
