Amending Title 61 (Prisons and Parole) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, 2 establishing the Pennsylvania Interagency Council on Inmate 3 Reentry. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 61 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 5908. Pennsylvania Interagency Council on Inmate Reentry. 10 (a) Establishment. -- The Pennsylvania Interagency Council on Inmate Reentry is established. 11 12 (b) Membership. -- The council shall consist of the following 13 members: 14 (1) The secretary, or a designee. 15 (2) The Secretary of Community and Economic Development, 16 or a designee. 17 (3) The Secretary of Education, or a designee. 18 (4) The Secretary of Labor and Industry, or a designee. (5) The Secretary of Human Services, or a designee.

- 1 (6) The Director of Homeland Security, or a designee.
- 2 (7) The Director of the Pennsylvania Emergency
- 3 Management Agency, or a designee.
- 4 (8) The Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Housing
- 5 <u>Finance Agency</u>, or a designee.
- 6 (9) The Adjutant General of the Department of Military
- 7 <u>and Veterans Affairs, or a designee.</u>
- 8 <u>(10) The Victim Advocate of the Office of Victim</u>
- 9 <u>Advocate, or a designee.</u>
- 10 (11) The Chairman of the Pennsylvania Board of Probation
- 11 <u>and Parole, or a designee.</u>
- 12 <u>(12) An elected county commissioner selected by the</u>
- 13 <u>County Commissioners Association of Pennsylvania.</u>
- 14 (13) An elected district attorney selected by the
- 15 Pennsylvania District Attorneys Association.
- 16 (14) The Executive Director of the Pennsylvania
- 17 Commission on Crime and Delinquency, or a designee.
- 18 (c) Quorum. -- A majority of the members shall constitute a
- 19 quorum and a vote of the majority of the members present shall
- 20 be sufficient for all actions.
- 21 (d) Chairperson. -- The secretary or the secretary's designee
- 22 shall serve as the chairperson of the council. A member of the
- 23 <u>council shall be designated by the chairperson as vice</u>
- 24 chairperson and shall preside at meetings in the absence of the
- 25 chairperson.
- 26 (e) Meetings.--The council shall meet at the call of the
- 27 chairperson but no less than six times per year.
- 28 (f) Reimbursement.--Members of the council shall serve
- 29 without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary and
- 30 reasonable expenses incurred in attending meetings of the

- 1 council and in the performance of the council's duties under
- 2 this section.
- 3 (g) Support. -- The department shall provide staff and
- 4 <u>administrative support for the council. The council may enter</u>
- 5 <u>into a memorandum of understanding with the Pennsylvania</u>
- 6 Commission on Crime and Delinquency for additional necessary
- 7 support.
- 8 <u>(h) Duties.--</u>
- 9 (1) The council shall examine:
- 10 (i) Methods of:
- 11 (A) Improving the process of reentering inmates
- into the community.
- 13 <u>(B) Strengthening the educational and vocational</u>
- skills of inmates while incarcerated.
- 15 (C) Establishing and implementing effective and
- 16 <u>consistent reentry plans prior to inmates' scheduled</u>
- 17 release into the community.
- 18 (D) Incentivizing employers to hire former
- 19 inmates through financial or other economic
- incentives.
- 21 (ii) The impediments to successful reentry plans,
- 22 including the use of employer background checks and
- 23 statutory and regulatory bars to employment.
- 24 (2) The council may rely on studies and reports that
- 25 have already been prepared by other state entities or private
- 26 organizations in its examination under this subsection.
- 27 <u>(i) Report to General Assembly.--The council shall submit a</u>
- 28 report to the General Assembly that provides the results of the
- 29 council's examination and findings under subsection (h) and
- 30 shall file the council's report with recommendations no later

- 1 than one year from the effective date of this section.
- 2 (j) Expiration. -- This section shall expire 365 days from the
- 3 <u>effective date of this section</u>.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
