AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain 2
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, providing for moment of silence on September 11 anniversary. 6
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 8
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- <u>Section 1555. Moment of Silence on September 11</u> 12
- Anniversary. -- (a) Each school entity shall conduct a moment of 13
- silence during instructional hours for students and faculty to 14
- 15 observe the anniversary of September 11, 2001, as a remembrance
- 16 of the thousands of military servicepersons, government
- 17 employees, civilians and emergency responders who lost their
- 18 lives or were wounded by terrorist attacks on that date.
- (b) The Department of Education shall establish a IDENTIFY <--19

- 1 model curriculum for instruction in the events and significance
- 2 <u>of September 11, 2001, no later than twelve (12) months after</u>
- 3 the effective date of this section. The model curriculum
- 4 IDENTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION shall include, but not <--
- 5 <u>be limited to, all of the following topics where appropriate:</u>
- 6 (1) The historical context of terrorism.
- 7 (2) The terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center, the
- 8 <u>Pentagon and United Airlines Flight 93 which crashed in</u>
- 9 <u>Shanksville</u>, <u>Pennsylvania</u>.
- 10 (3) American recovery and response to the attacks.
- 11 (4) Global challenges and consequences in a post-September-
- 12 11 world.
- 13 (c) The Department of Education shall make available on the
- 14 department's publicly accessible Internet website curriculum
- 15 materials and other available resources regarding the events and
- 16 <u>significance of September 11, 2001, for voluntary use by school</u>
- 17 entities.
- 18 (d) Nothing in subsections (b) and (c) shall be construed to
- 19 require a school entity or nonpublic school to implement, adopt
- 20 or use the curriculum, materials and other resources made
- 21 available by the department under this section.
- 22 (e) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"
- 23 shall mean a school district, charter school, regional charter
- 24 school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit or area career
- 25 and technical school.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
