AN ACT

Amending the act of December 2, 1968 (P.L.1144, No.358), entitled "An act to provide for the office of public defender, authorizing assistants and other personnel, and to 2 3 provide adequate representation for persons who have been charged with an indictable offense or with being a juvenile 5 delinquent, who for lack of sufficient funds are unable to 6 obtain legal counsel," further providing for expenses for 7 parole proceedings. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. Section 10.1 of the act of December 2, 1968 12 (P.L.1144, No.358), known as the Public Defender Act, added 13 December 23, 1981 (P.L.590, No.172), is amended to read: 14 Section 10.1. Expenses for Parole and Mental Health Proceedings .-- (a) The county which imposed the sentence from 15 16 which the defendant was paroled shall be responsible for 17 reimbursing the public defender's office of any other county for 18 reasonable expenses incurred for representing that defendant in 19 a parole revocation proceeding and appeals therefrom. 20 (b) The county which imposed the sentence to a State or county correctional institution shall be responsible for

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- 1 reimbursing the public defender's office of any other county for
- 2 <u>reasonable expenses incurred for representing an inmate in</u>
- 3 proceedings under the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L.817, No.143),
- 4 known as the "Mental Health Procedures Act," and appeals
- 5 therefrom.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
