## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, further 5 providing for exceptional children and education and 6 7 training. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1372(8)(i), (ii) and (iv) of the act of 11 March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code 12 of 1949, amended July 8, 2022 (P.L.620, No.55), are amended to 13 read: 14 Section 1372. Exceptional Children; Education and 15 Training.--\* \* \* 16 (8) Reporting of Expenditures Relating to Exceptional 17 Students. 18 (i) By December 31, [2000] 2023, and each year thereafter, 19 each school district shall compile information listing the

number of [students with disabilities] children with

- 1 <u>exceptionalities</u> for which expenditures are between twenty-five
- 2 thousand dollars (\$25,000) and fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000),
- 3 which shall be known as Category 2; between fifty thousand
- 4 dollars (\$50,000) and seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000),
- 5 which shall be known as Category 3A; and over seventy-five
- 6 thousand dollars (\$75,000), which shall be known as Category 3B,
- 7 for the prior school year. The information shall be submitted to
- 8 the department in a form prescribed by the department. By
- 9 February 1, 2001, and each year thereafter, the department shall
- 10 submit to the chairman and minority chairman of the Education
- 11 and Appropriations Committees of the Senate and the chairman and
- 12 minority chairman of the Education and Appropriations Committees
- 13 of the House of Representatives a report listing this
- 14 information by school district. Beginning with the report due
- 15 February 1, 2023, the department shall include the information
- 16 reported in subparagraph (iv) along with the report made in this
- 17 subparagraph and shall post the report on the department's
- 18 publicly accessible Internet website in a sortable electronic
- 19 format.
- 20 (ii) By December 31, [2016] <u>2023</u>, and each year thereafter,
- 21 each school district shall compile information listing the
- 22 number of [students with disabilities] children with
- 23 <u>exceptionalities</u> for which expenditures are under twenty-five
- 24 thousand dollars (\$25,000), which shall be known as Category 1.
- 25 The information shall be submitted to the department in a form
- 26 prescribed by the department.

- 28 (iv) By December 31, [2022] 2023, and each year thereafter,
- 29 each school district shall, in addition to the information under
- 30 subparagraph (i), compile information listing the number of

- 1 [students with disabilities] children with exceptionalities for
- 2 which expenditures are under five thousand dollars (\$5,000),
- 3 which shall be known as Category 1A; and between five thousand
- 4 dollars (\$5,000) and less than the amount in Category 2, which
- 5 shall be known as Category 1B, for the prior school year. The
- 6 information shall be submitted to the department along with the
- 7 information in, and as prescribed by, subparagraph (i).

- 9 Section 2. Any regulations of the Department of Education
- 10 that are inconsistent with this act are abrogated to the extent
- 11 of the inconsistency.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
