12	addition to any public notice required under this section, an
13	agency shall provide the following notification of agency
14	business to be considered at a public meeting as follows:
15	(1) The agency shall post the agenda, which includes a
16	listing of each matter of agency business that will be or may
17	be the subject of deliberation or official action at the
18	meeting, on its publicly accessible Internet website no later
19	than 24 hours in advance of the time of the convening of the

2	(2) The agency shall post the agenda, which includes a
3	listing of each matter of agency business that will be or may
4	be the subject of deliberation or official action at the
5	meeting, at the location of the meeting.
6	(3) The agency shall make available to individuals in
7	attendance at the meeting copies of the agenda, which include
8	a listing of each matter of agency business that will be or
9	may be the subject of deliberation or official action at the
10	meeting.

14	(a) Official actionExcept as provided in subsection (b),
15	an agency may not take official action on a matter of agency
16	business at a meeting if the matter was not included in the
17	notification required under section 709(c.1) (relating to public
18	<u>notice).</u>
19	(b) Emergency businessAn agency may take official action
20	on a matter of agency business relating to a real or potential
21	emergency involving a clear and present danger to life or
22	property at an emergency meeting regardless of whether public
23	notice was given for the meeting.
24	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
