- 23 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter

- 29 (a) Authorization.--On request of a member THE CHAIR OR
- 30 MINORITY CHAIR OF THE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE AND THE CHAIR OR

- 1 MINORITY CHAIR OF THE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE of either chamber of
- 2 the General Assembly, the commission shall complete a
- 3 demographic impact statement for any bill or amendment to a bill
- 4 proposing a change to 42 Pa.C.S. Ch. 97 (relating to sentencing)
- 5 or 18 Pa.C.S. (relating to crimes and offenses) to determine the
- 6 impact, if any, the proposed bill or amendment may have on the
- 7 <u>demographic composition of the criminal offender population or <--</u>
- 8 juvenile court system. The demographic impact statement shall be
- 9 <u>impartial</u>, <u>simple</u> and <u>understandable</u>.
- 10 (b) Bill.--Except as otherwise provided in subsection (e)
- 11 (1), a bill for which a demographic impact statement has been
- 12 requested under subsection (a) may not be given second
- 13 consideration by the chamber of the General Assembly whose
- 14 member made the request until such time as the commission has
- 15 <u>attached the demographic impact statement.</u>
- 16 (c) Amendment. -- Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 17 (e)(2), neither an amendment for which a demographic impact
- 18 statement has been requested under subsection (a) nor the bill
- 19 to which the amendment is offered shall be considered by the
- 20 chamber of the General Assembly whose member made the request
- 21 until such time as the commission has attached the demographic
- 22 impact statement.
- 23 (d) Contents. -- For groups for which data is available
- 24 regarding racial and ethnic composition, geographic and
- 25 socioeconomic status, age, gender and religious and
- 26 ethnoreligious affiliations AND GENDER, the demographic impact <--

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- 27 statement shall include the following:
- 28 (1) An estimate of how the legislation would change the
- 29 <u>demographic composition of the criminal offender population</u>
- 30 and juvenile court system.

3	(3) An estimate of the demographic composition of the	<
4	crime victims who may be affected by the legislation.	
5	(e) Failure to attach	
6	(1) If the commission fails to attach a demographic	
7	<pre>impact statement to a bill within 10 BUSINESS days after a</pre>	<
8	request for a statement has been submitted to the commission,	
9	the bill may be further considered in the same manner as if	
10	the demographic impact statement is attached to the bill.	
11	(2) If the commission fails to attach a demographic	
12	impact statement to an amendment within 10 BUSINESS days	<
13	after a request for a statement has been submitted to the	
14	commission, the bill and the amendment may be considered in	
15	the same manner as if the demographic impact statement is	
16	attached to the amendment.	
17	Section $\frac{2}{3}$. This act shall take effect in 60 days.	<
