## AN ACT

11	knowingly, recklessly or negligently endangers the life or
12	health of a child by exposing or allowing exposure of the child
13	to an environment where a drug is delivered, stored, processed,
14	compounded, packaged, possessed, consumed, concealed, used or
15	otherwise present in violation of the act of April 14, 1972
16	(P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug,
17	Device and Cosmetic Act.
18	(b) Aggravated drug-related child endangermentA person

1	commits the offense of aggravated drug-related child
2	endangerment when the person violates subsection (a) and:
3	(1) the child suffers serious bodily injury as a result
4	of acts constituting the offense; or
5	(2) the child dies as a result of acts constituting the
6	<u>offense.</u>
