## AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
  Consolidated Statutes, in veterans' pensions and benefits,
- further providing for blind veteran's pension and for amputee
- and paralyzed veteran's pension.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Sections 7701(b) and 7702(a) of Title 51 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 7701. Blind veteran's pension.

- 11 (b) Amount and eligibility. -- In addition to any other
- 12 assistance provided by the Commonwealth and in addition to any
- 13 compensation provided by the Federal Government, every blind
- 14 veteran shall be paid a pension of [\$150] \$200 per month.
- 15 Applications for such pensions shall be made to and in the form
- 16 prescribed by the department. The Adjutant General shall have
- 17 the power, and it shall be his duty to determine the eligibility

- 1 of every applicant for a pension, and his decision in the matter
- 2 shall be final.
- 3 § 7702. Amputee and paralyzed veteran's pension.
- 4 (a) Amount and eligibility. -- In addition to any other
- 5 assistance provided by the Commonwealth and in addition to any
- 6 compensation provided by the Federal Government, every amputee
- 7 and paralyzed veteran shall be paid a pension of [\$150] \$200 per
- 8 month. Applications for the pensions shall be made to and in the
- 9 form prescribed by the department. The Adjutant General shall
- 10 determine the eligibility of every applicant for a pension, and
- 11 his decision in the matter shall be final.
