AN ACT

- Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in particular rights and immunities, providing for rescue from motor vehicle. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 42 is amended by adding a section to read: 7 § 8340.3. Rescue from motor vehicle. 8 (a) (Reserved). 9 (b) Rescue of animal DOG OR CAT. -- No law enforcement <--
- 10 officer, ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER, humane society police officer <--
- 11 or emergency responder, or the employer of a law enforcement
- 12 <u>officer</u>, humane society police officer or emergency responder,
- 13 <u>shall be liable for damage to a motor vehicle or the contents</u>
- 14 thereof caused by entry into the motor vehicle for the purpose
- 15 of removing an animal A DOG OR CAT, if the law enforcement <
- 16 officer, humane society police officer or emergency responder:

1	(1) Has a good-faith, reasonable belief that the animal	<
2	DOG OR CAT is in imminent danger of suffering harm if not	<
3	immediately removed from the motor vehicle.	
4	(2) Makes a reasonable effort to locate the driver of	
5	the motor vehicle prior to entry.	
6	(3) Takes reasonable steps to ensure or restore the	
7	well-being of the animal DOG OR CAT.	<
8	(4) Uses no more force than necessary under the	
9	circumstances to enter the motor vehicle.	
10	(5) Leaves notice on or in the motor vehicle stating the	_
11	reason entry was made, the name of the person and of the	
12	person's employer, a telephone number and, if possible, the	
13	location where the animal DOG OR CAT may be retrieved.	<
14	(c) Limitation A person shall not be immune from civil	
15	liability for damage resulting from the entry if the person's	
16	actions constitute gross negligence, recklessness or willful or	
17	wanton misconduct.	
18	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
