7	Section 1. The City of Johnstown Firefighters Memorial Bridge.
8	(a) FindingsThe General Assembly finds and declares as

10	(1) The men and women who served as firefighters
11	dedicated their lives and careers to help others in times of
12	need and those who gave their lives deserve recognition.

6 (3) THE BRIDGE SHALL ALSO COMMEMORATE ANY FUTURE FALLEN <--
7 FIREFIGHTERS FROM THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN'S FIRE DEPARTMENT WHO
8 DEDICATED THEIR LIVES AND CAREERS TO HELP OTHERS IN TIMES OF
9 NEED.

10 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8680, 11 carrying State Route 3055 over Stonycreek River in the City of 12 Johnstown, Cambria County, is designated as the City of 13 Johnstown Firefighters Memorial Bridge.

14 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and 15 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to 16 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

17 Section 2. Effective date.
