14	Section 1. The act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known
15	as the Health Care Facilities Act, is amended by adding a

17	Section 822. Culture and Quality of Life Certification Program.
18	<u>(a) EstablishmentThe department shall establish a Culture</u>
19	and Quality of Life Certification Program.
20	(b) CertificationLong-term care nursing facilities may
21	apply for the special certification, through the department,
22	which shall recognize the facility's effort to create a home-

1	like environment and cultural opportunities for its residents,
2	including, but not limited to:
3	(1) An individual-centered approach to care.
4	(2) Social interactions.
5	(3) Partnerships with the community and volunteer
6	organizations.
7	(4) Participation of family and friends.
8	(5) Creative arts.
9	(6) Diversity of activities available to residents.
10	(7) Attention to cultural considerations.
11	(8) Creation of a home-like design aesthetic.
12	(9) Outdoor facilities such as patios, decks and
13	gardens.
14	(c) RegulationsRegulations, including the application and
15	approval process, shall be promulgated by the department.
16	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
