AN ACT

- Prohibiting bonuses and certain types of salary increases for employees of Commonwealth agencies.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Commonwealth
- 7 Agency Remuneration Equality Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Bonus." Monetary compensation given to an employee beyond
- 13 the employee's annual salary or other rate of pay. The term does
- 14 not include any of the following:
- 15 (1) Reimbursement or payments for expenses related to
- official business, including meals, lodging, uniforms, car or
- mileage and other expenses.
- 18 (2) Severance payments under a personnel compensation

- 1 plan, contract or collective bargaining agreement.
- 2 (3) Payments for unused vacation or sick leave.
- 3 (4) An annual cost-of-living adjustment equivalency
- 4 payment made to an individual, at the maximum of a salary
- 5 range, adopted under a personnel compensation plan or a
- 6 collective bargaining agreement.
- 7 (5) An arbitration award.
- 8 (6) Payments made pursuant to litigation.
- 9 (7) Overtime compensation.
- 10 (8) Annual performance-based incentive payments based on
- objective criteria made under a personnel compensation plan
- included in an individual employment contract or collective
- 13 bargaining agreement.
- 14 (9) Shift differential payments, standby or call-time
- payments or extra duty payments made under a collective
- 16 bargaining agreement.
- 17 A personnel compensation plan, contract or collective bargaining
- 18 agreement under this definition shall be in writing and shall be
- 19 open for public inspection.
- "Commonwealth agency." Any of the following:
- 21 (1) The Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General,
- 22 Auditor General, State Treasurer and the departments,
- offices, boards, authorities, commissions and other agencies
- of the executive branch of the Commonwealth, whether or not
- subject to the supervision and control of the Governor.
- 26 (2) The General Assembly of the Commonwealth.
- 27 (3) Any court or office of the unified judicial system
- of the Commonwealth.
- 29 Section 3. Bonuses prohibited.
- No Commonwealth agency may pay a bonus to any of its

- 1 employees.
- 2 Section 4. Penalties.
- 3 (a) Reimbursement. -- An employee of a Commonwealth agency who
- 4 is paid a bonus after the effective date of this act shall
- 5 reimburse the employer for the full amount of the bonus.
- 6 (b) Criminal offense. -- A person who knowingly and willingly
- 7 approves or authorizes a bonus prohibited by this act commits a
- 8 misdemeanor of the third degree.
- 9 Section 5. Applicability.
- 10 The provisions of this act shall not abrogate any provision
- 11 of an existing collective bargaining agreement or employment
- 12 contract.
- 13 Section 6. Effective date.
- 14 This act shall take effect immediately.
