## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, further
- providing for prohibition on certain service.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 7713 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 7713. Prohibition on certain service.
- 9 A person convicted of violating 18 Pa.C.S. § 3301 (relating
- 10 to arson and related offenses), an offense classified as a Tier
- 11 I, II or III sexual offense under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9799.14 (relating
- 12 to sexual offenses and tier system) or any similar offense under
- 13 Federal or State law shall be prohibited from serving as a
- 14 firefighter in this Commonwealth and shall be prohibited from
- 15 being certified as a firefighter under Subchapter F of Chapter
- 16 73 (relating to State Fire Commissioner). Proof of nonconviction
- 17 must consist of either of the following:
- 18 (1) An official criminal history record check obtained

1 under 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 91 (relating to criminal history record 2 information) indicating no arson convictions.

A dated and signed statement by the person swearing to the following:

> I have never been convicted of an offense that constitutes the crime of "arson and related offenses" under 18 Pa.C.S. § 3301, an offense classified as a Tier I, II or III sexual offense under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9799.14 or any similar offense under any Federal or State law. I hereby certify that the statements contained herein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand that if I knowingly make any false statement herein, I am subject to penalties prescribed by law, including, but not limited to, a fine of at least \$1,000.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 16
