AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, providing 5 for transfer of attendance records to another school entity 6 or nonpublic school. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 12 section to read: Section 1313.2. Transfer of Attendance Records to Another 13 School Entity or Nonpublic School. -- (a) (1) Whenever a student 14 transfers to another school entity or nonpublic school within 15 16 this Commonwealth, a certified copy of the student's attendance 17 record shall be transmitted to the school entity or nonpublic 18 school to which the student has transferred.
- 19 (2) The school entity or nonpublic school to which the

- 1 student has transferred shall request the attendance record.
- 2 (3) The sending school entity or nonpublic school shall have
- 3 ten (10) days from the receipt of the request to provide a
- 4 <u>certified copy of the student's attendance record.</u>
- 5 (b) In the case of a student transferring during the course
- 6 of a school term, the student's unexcused absences shall be
- 7 included in the student's attendance record at the school entity
- 8 or nonpublic school to which the student has transferred for
- 9 <u>that school term.</u>
- 10 (c) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"
- 11 means a public school district, charter school, cyber charter
- 12 school, regional charter school, intermediate unit or area
- 13 vocational-technical school.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
