AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for railroad trains not to block crossings.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3713 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3713. Railroad trains not to block crossings.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- No person or government agency shall
- 10 operate any train in such a manner as to prevent vehicular use
- 11 of any roadway for a period of time in excess of five
- 12 consecutive minutes except under any of the following
- 13 circumstances:
- 14 (1) When necessary to comply with signals affecting the
- safety of the movement of trains.
- 16 (2) When necessary to avoid striking any object or
- 17 person on the track.
- 18 (3) When the train is disabled.

- 1 (4) When the train is in motion except while engaged in
- 2 switching operations.
- 3 (5) When there is no vehicular traffic waiting to use
- 4 the crossings.
- 5 (6) When necessary to comply with a governmental safety
- 6 regulation.
- 7 (b) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 8 <u>summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay</u>
- 9 <u>a fine of \$500.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
