## AN ACT

Designating a bridge on that portion of state Route 263 over the-<-Pennypack Creck BYBERRY AVENUE FROM WARMINSTER ROAD TO YORK <-ROAD, Borough of Hatboro, Montgomery County, as the SP4 Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., Memorial Bridge HIGHWAY.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. SP4 Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., Memorial Bridge- <-HIGHWAY.

(a) Findings.--
(1) Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., a resident of Hatboro, Montgomery County, began his tour of duty in Vietnam on November 15, 1968, as a Specialist 4 with the 101st Airborne Division.
(2) On June 5, 1969, SP4 Ruttle, age 23, was killed in Quang Tin Province by an enemy explosive device while
valiantly serving his country.
(b) Designation.--The bridge located on State Route 263
