9	(a) Findings	
10	(1) Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., a resident of Hatboro,	
11	Montgomery County, began his tour of duty in Vietnam on	
12	November 15, 1968, as a Specialist 4 with the 101st Airborne	
13	Division.	
14	(2) On June 5, 1969, SP4 Ruttle, age 23, was killed in	
15	Quang Tin Province by an enemy explosive device while	

1 valiantly serving his country.

2 Designation.--The bridge located on State Route 263 (b) <---BYBERRY AVENUE FROM WARMINSTER ROAD TO YORK ROAD, Borough of 3 <---Hatboro, Montgomery County, over the Pennypack Creek is hereby 4 <--designated the SP4 Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., Memorial Bridge 5 <---HIGHWAY. 6 <---

7 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
8 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge <--
9 HIGHWAY to traffic in both directions on the bridge HIGHWAY. <--
