1 2 4 5 6 7 8 9	To the act of April 1, 1863 (P.L.213, No.227), entitled "An act to accept the grant of Public Lands, by the United States, to the several states, for the endowment of Agricultural Colleges," making appropriations for carrying the same into effect; providing for a basis for payments of such appropriations, for a method of accounting for the funds appropriated and for certain fiscal information disclosure; and making an appropriation from a restricted account within the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund.
10	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
11	hereby enacts as follows:
12	Section 1. In order to carry into effect the act of
13	Congress, approved July 2, 1862, granting public land to the
14	several states for educational purposes, and subsequent acts of
15	Congress related thereto, and the act of the General Assembly of
16	Pennsylvania accepting the provisions and conditions of said
17	acts of Congress and pledging the faith of the State to carry
18	the same into effect, the following sums, or as much thereof as
19	may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of The
20	Pennsylvania State University for the fiscal year July 1, 2019,
21	to June 30, 2020, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:

1 For general support.

State appropriation..... \$22,736,000<--</pre> STATE APPROPRIATION..... 6 \$26,736,000<---7 Section 2. Payments to The Pennsylvania State University on 8 account of the appropriations for all items as provided in 9 section 1 shall be made on the basis of costs during the fiscal 10 year.

Section 3. (a) Payments to The Pennsylvania State 11 University of the appropriations provided in section 1 shall be 12 made monthly during the fiscal year. 13

Such monthly payments shall be made in accordance with 14 (b) the provisions of section 2 on the basis of estimated costs. The 15 16 estimate of costs shall be submitted by The Pennsylvania State University to the Secretary of Education, the General Assembly 17 and the State Treasurer not later than 30 days prior to the date 18 on which such payment is to be made. 19

20 Section 4. (a) The Pennsylvania State University shall 21 apply the money appropriated by this act only for such purposes as are permitted in this act and shall at all times maintain 22 proper records showing the application of such money. Not later 23 than 120 days after the close of the fiscal year to which this 24 25 act relates, The Pennsylvania State University shall file, with 26 the Secretary of Education, the General Assembly and the Auditor 27 General of the Commonwealth, a statement setting forth the amounts and purposes of all expenditures made from money 28 29 appropriated by this act and other university accounts during 30 said fiscal year, as provided in section 2, used as a basis for

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1 receipt of any appropriation during said fiscal year.

2 Such statement of expenditures and costs shall be (b) 3 reviewed by the Auditor General of the Commonwealth, and he shall have the right, in respect to the money appropriated by 4 this act, to audit and disallow expenditures made for purposes 5 not permitted by this act and to cause such sums to be recovered 6 and paid by The Pennsylvania State University to the State 7 8 Treasurer. In respect to expenditures made by the university from money other than that appropriated by this act, the Auditor 9 General shall have the right to review only, and he shall file 10 11 annually with the General Assembly such information concerning 12 such expenditures as the General Assembly or any of its 13 committees may require.

14 Section 5. The Pennsylvania State University shall provide 15 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by 16 the Department of Education or the chairperson or minority 17 chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the 18 chairperson or minority chairperson of the Appropriations 19 Committee of the House of Representatives.

20 Section 6. The Pennsylvania State University shall present 21 and report its financial statements required under the provisions of this act in accordance with: the generally 22 accepted accounting principles as prescribed by the National 23 Association of College and University Business Officers, the 24 25 American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, or their 26 successors, or by any other recognized authoritative body; the 27 "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-28 State-Related Colleges and Universities"; and, the financial 29 30 reporting policies and standards promulgated by the Federal

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Government and by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that apply to
The Pennsylvania State University.

3 Section 7. The money of the restricted account within the 4 Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund is hereby appropriated for 5 the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020, in accordance 6 with the provisions of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, 7 No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, establishing the restricted 8 account.

9 Section 8. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, or10 immediately, whichever is later.

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
