AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 7 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 12 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel 17 thoroughbred horse racing and harness horse racing 18 19 activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the 20 disposition of funds from pari-mutuel tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 21 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 22 23 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be determined," in Commonwealth agency fees, further providing 24 for Department of State. 25 26 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 27 hereby enacts as follows: 28 Section 1. 25	section, the Department of State shall make available and
26	publish in the Pennsylvania Bulletin a uniform form to request
27	the legalization of documents. The form shall include all of the

- 2 (4) Telephone number.
- 3 (5) Country for which documents are being prepared.
- 4 (6) Number of documents to be certified.
- 5 (7) Purpose of request.
- 6 (8) Signature of requester.
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
