AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 22, 1983 (P.L.306, No.84), entitled
2 "An act providing for the State Board of Vehicle
3 Manufacturers, Dealers and Salespersons; and providing
4 penalties," further providing for grounds for disciplinary
5 proceedings and for off-premise sales, shows, exhibitions or
6 rallies on Sundays.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 318(10) of the act of December 22, 1983
10 (P.L.306, No.84), known as the Board of Vehicles Act, renumbered
11 and amended October 24, 2018 (P.L.816, No.134), is amended to
12 read:

13 Section 318. Grounds for disciplinary proceedings.

14 In addition to any criminal or civil penalties otherwise
15 provided in this act, the board shall have the power to formally
16 reprimand, suspend or revoke any license or refuse to issue or
17 renew any license of an applicant or licensee or a person
18 required to be licensed under this act, if after due notice of
19 and hearing, the person charged is found in violation of or
20 fails to carry out the acts and procedures set forth in this act

1 or is found guilty of committing or attempting to commit any of
2 the acts set forth in section 322 or any of the following acts:

3 * * *

4 (10) Having engaged in the buying, selling, exchanging,
5 trading or otherwise dealing in vehicles on Sunday in
6 violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 7365 (relating to trading in motor
7 vehicles and trailers) [.] , except that:

8 (i) Manufactured housing is permitted to be sold on
9 Sundays by licensed manufactured housing dealers without
10 being subject to prosecution under this paragraph.

11 (ii) Licensed motorcycle dealers are permitted to
12 buy, sell, exchange, trade or otherwise deal in
13 motorcycles on Sunday without being subject to
14 prosecution under this paragraph.

15 (iii) Motor vehicles are permitted to be sold on
16 Sundays by normal vehicle business dealers pursuant to
17 section 333(5) without being subject to prosecution under
18 this paragraph.

20 Section 2. Section 333 of the act, renumbered October 24,
21 2018 (P.L.816, No.134), is amended to read:

22 Section 333. [Off-premise sales] Sales, shows, exhibitions or
23 rallies on Sundays.

24 (1) The following shall be permitted to be open on
25 Sundays:

26 (i) Off-premise vehicle sales, shows and
27 exhibitions.

28 (ii) Recreational vehicle shows, recreational
29 vehicle off-premise sales, recreational vehicle
30 exhibitions and recreational vehicle rallies.

1 (2) Except as provided in paragraphs (3) [~~and~~], (4) and
2 (5), normal vehicle business practices shall be allowed at
3 off-premise sales, vehicle shows or exhibitions on Sunday
4 except that no final sales contract may be consummated on a
5 Sunday.

6 (3) Normal vehicle business practices shall be allowed
7 at recreational vehicle shows, recreational vehicle off-
8 premise sales, recreational vehicle exhibitions and
9 recreational vehicle rallies. Recreational vehicle dealers
10 are permitted to consummate final sales contracts on Sundays.

11 (4) Manufactured housing dealers are permitted to
12 consummate final sales contracts on Sundays.

13 (5) Normal vehicle business dealers shall be permitted
14 to be open Sundays for on-premise sales and shall be
15 permitted to consummate final sales contracts on Sundays.

16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
