AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in charter schools, establishing the Cyber Charter School Funding Advisory Commission. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 1704-A. Cyber Charter School Funding Advisory</u>
- 13 Commission. -- (a) The Cyber Charter School Funding Advisory
- 14 Commission is established.
- 15 (b) The commission shall examine all current laws,
- 16 regulations and executive policy statements which determine
- 17 funding for cyber charter schools in this Commonwealth.
- 18 <u>(c) The commission shall consist of the following:</u>
- 19 <u>(1) The secretary or a designee.</u>
- 20 (2) One member appointed by the President pro tempore of the

- 1 <u>Senate</u>.
- 2 (3) One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
- 3 Senate.
- 4 (4) One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 5 <u>Representatives.</u>
- 6 (5) One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the House
- 7 <u>of Representatives.</u>
- 8 (6) The chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations
- 9 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman
- 10 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 11 (7) The chairman and minority chairman of the Education
- 12 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman
- 13 of the Education Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 14 (d) The commission shall hold its organizational meeting no
- 15 <u>later than sixty (60) days following the effective date of this</u>
- 16 <u>section</u>. All members shall be appointed within thirty (30) days
- 17 of the effective date of this section. Any vacancy on the
- 18 commission shall be filled by the original appointing authority.
- 19 (e) The commission shall elect two commission chairmen from
- 20 the members appointed under subsection (c), one member appointed
- 21 by the Senate and one member appointed by the House of
- 22 Representatives.
- 23 (f) The commission shall hold meetings at the call of the
- 24 chairmen. The commission shall hold at least six (6) public
- 25 hearings on the matters to be considered by the commission. All
- 26 meetings and public hearings of the commission shall be deemed
- 27 <u>public meetings for the purpose of 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating to</u>
- 28 open meetings). Seven (7) members of the commission shall
- 29 <u>constitute a quorum at any meeting.</u>
- 30 (g) The commission members shall receive no compensation for

- 1 their services but shall be reimbursed for all necessary travel
- 2 and other reasonable expenses incurred in connection with the
- 3 performance of their duties as members.
- 4 (h) The commission shall have the following powers and
- 5 <u>duties:</u>
- 6 (1) To meet with current cyber charter school operators and
- 7 personnel, school district personnel and other representatives
- 8 of public education.
- 9 (2) To review cyber charter school financing laws in
- 10 operation throughout the United States.
- 11 (3) To assess the actual cost of educating a child in a
- 12 cyber charter school and a school district or intermediate unit
- 13 <u>utilizing cyber classes.</u>
- 14 (4) To evaluate and make recommendations on the following:
- 15 (i) The process by which cyber charter schools are funded.
- 16 <u>(ii) Appropriate funding for cyber charter school</u>
- 17 operations.
- 18 <u>(iii) Appropriate funding for cyber charter school</u>
- 19 facilities and management.
- 20 <u>(iv) Other funding issues raised in the course of public</u>
- 21 hearings.
- 22 (v) Appropriate funding for cyber charter school special
- 23 <u>education programs</u>.
- 24 (i) The General Assembly shall provide administrative
- 25 support, meeting space and any other assistance required by the
- 26 commission to carry out its duties under this section. Whenever
- 27 possible, the commission shall utilize the services and
- 28 expertise of existing personnel and staff of State government.
- 29 <u>(j) The commission shall, no later than twelve (12) months</u>
- 30 from the effective date of this section, issue a report of its

- 1 findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President pro
- 2 tempore of the Senate, the Majority Leader of the Senate, the
- 3 Minority Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
- 4 Representatives, the Majority Leader of the House of
- 5 Representatives and the Minority Leader of the House of
- 6 Representatives. The findings and recommendations of the
- 7 commission shall be accompanied with drafts of legislation as
- 8 the commission deems necessary for the information of and
- 9 consideration by the General Assembly.
- 10 (k) As used in this section, the term "commission" means the
- 11 Cyber Charter School Funding Advisory Commission established
- 12 <u>under subsection (a)</u>.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
