## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 1, 1974 (P.L.90, No.24), entitled "An act relating to the labeling, distribution, storage, 2 transportation, use, application and disposal of pesticides 3 and devices; providing for registration and examination of such materials; the licensing of pesticide dealers and pest 5 management consultants and imposing penalties," further providing for definitions; and providing for notification. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 9 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 4 of the act of March 1, 1974 (P.L.90, 11 No.24), known as the Pennsylvania Pesticide Control Act of 1973, 12 is amended by adding paragraphs to read: 13 Section 4. Definitions. -- As used in this act: 14 15 (34.1) "Private park" means privately owned outdoor real 16 estate which includes a recreational area for use by the public, including an area with restricted access. 17 \* \* \* 18 19
  - (36.1) "Public park" means publicly owned outdoor real

- 6 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 <u>Section 27.1. Notification.--For pesticide applications to a</u>
- 8 private park or to a public park, notice of the date of proposed
- 9 <u>pesticide application shall be provided by placing a sign at</u>
- 10 <u>each entrance to the private park or public park. Notice shall</u>
- 11 <u>be provided not less than 72 hours nor more than seven days</u>
- 12 prior to the pesticide application.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
