8	(3) An individual who is at least 12 years of age may be
9	employed as a youth sports official - AND SHALL NOT BE <
10	REQUIRED TO PROCURE A WORK PERMIT. YOUTH SPORTS OFFICIALS WHO
11	ARE 12 AND 13 YEARS OF AGE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE SAME
12	LIMITATIONS ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 3 FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE
13	14 AND 15 YEARS OF AGE.
