## AN ACT

- Authorizing the incurring of indebtedness, with the approval of 1
- the electors, of up to \$150,000,000 for the preservation of 2 3
  - land for open-space uses and for the mitigation of flood
- hazards.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Referendum.
- Pursuant to the provisions of section 7(a)(3) of Article VIII 8
- of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, the question of incurring
- indebtedness of up to \$150,000,000 for the preservation of land 10
- 11 for open-space uses and for the mitigation of flood hazards
- shall be submitted to electors at the next primary, municipal or 12
- general election following the effective date of this act. 1.3
- Section 2. Certification. 14
- 15 The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall certify the question
- 16 to the county boards of elections.
- 17 Section 3. Form of question.
- The question shall be in the following form: 18

- 1 Do you favor authorizing the Commonwealth to borrow up to
- 2 \$150,000,000 for the preservation of land for open-space
- 3 uses and for the mitigation of flood hazards?
- 4 Section 4. Conduct of referendum.
- 5 The election shall be conducted in accordance with the act of
- 6 June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania
- 7 Election Code, except that:
- 8 (1) Any requirements for advertising or notice related
- 9 to the question are hereby waived.
- 10 (2) The requirement for a statement pursuant to section
- 11 201.1 of the Pennsylvania Election Code is hereby waived.
- 12 (3) Any authority of the Secretary of the Commonwealth
- 13 to determine the form of the question is abrogated.
- 14 Section 5. Use of bond proceeds.
- 15 Proceeds of borrowing shall be used as determined by the
- 16 General Assembly by law for the mitigation of flood hazards and
- 17 to promote the purposes of the act of January 19, 1968 (1967)
- 18 P.L.992, No.442), entitled, as amended, "An act authorizing the
- 19 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the local government units
- 20 thereof to preserve, acquire or hold land for open space uses."
- 21 Section 6. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
