## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 27, 2014 (P.L.2911, No.191), entitled "An act providing for prescription drug monitoring; creating the ABC-MAP Board; establishing the Achieving Better Care by Monitoring All Prescriptions Program; and providing for unlawful acts and penalties," further providing for access to prescription information. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 9(b) of the act of October 27, 2014 10 (P.L.2911, No.191), known as the Achieving Better Care by 11 Monitoring All Prescriptions Program (ABC MAP) Act, is amended 12 by adding a paragraph to read: SECTION 1. SECTION 9(B)(7) OF THE ACT OF OCTOBER 27, 2014 13 14 (P.L.2911, NO.191), KNOWN AS THE ACHIEVING BETTER CARE BY 15 MONITORING ALL PRESCRIPTIONS PROGRAM (ABC-MAP) ACT, IS AMENDED 16 AND THE SUBSECTION IS AMENDED BY ADDING A PARAGRAPH TO READ: 17 Section 9. Access to prescription information.

1 Authorized users. -- The following individuals may query 2 the system according to procedures determined by the board and 3 with the following limitations: 4 5 A Medicaid managed care organization, 6 section 1903(m)(1)(A) of the Social Security Act Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. § 1396b(m)(1)(A)), that is a party to 7 8 Medicaid managed care contract with the Department of Human 9 Services. The following shall apply: 10 (i) The Medicaid managed care organization may 11 the system to review the requested dispensing prescribing of a controlled substance under this act to 12 13 an individual to whom the organization provides services 14 under the State's plan for medical assistance under Title 15 XIX of the Social Security Act. 16 (ii) The Medicaid managed care organization shall notify the Department of Human Services and the Office of 17 18 Attorney General if the organization has reason 19 believe that a controlled substance prescribed or 20 dispensed to an enrollee under the State's plan for 21 medical assistance under Title XIX of the Social Securi Act is fraudulent. 23 DESIGNATED COMMONWEALTH PERSONNEL AND CONTRACTED 24

15	(II) SHALL NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES
16	AND THE OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL IF FRAUD IS SUSPECTED
17	BASED ON THE RESULTS OF THE QUERY AND REVIEW OF THE
18	DATABASE.
