AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for heat alert systems in K-9 vehicles.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 3701.2. Heat alert system in a K-9 law enforcement vehicle.
- 8 (a) Requirement. -- A law enforcement agency must equip each
- 9 vehicle used in a K-9 law enforcement program with a heat alert
- 10 system that is activated when the temperature in the vehicle's
- 11 interior becomes dangerous to a police dog in the vehicle. The
- 12 system, when activated, must do all of the following:
- 13 <u>(1) Activate an audible alarm.</u>
- 14 (2) Automatically lower at least two windows in the
- 15 vehicle.
- 16 (3) Send an electronic message to the K-9 law
- 17 enforcement officer.

- 1 (b) Compliance.--
- 2 (1) A law enforcement agency that has a K-9 law
- 3 enforcement program in existence on the effective date of
- 4 this section must comply with this section by January 1,
- 5 2018.
- 6 (2) A law enforcement agency that implements a K-9 law
- 7 <u>enforcement program after December 31, 2017, must comply with</u>
- 8 this section not later than one year after the date the
- 9 <u>program begins operation.</u>
- 10 (c) Applicability. -- This section shall not apply to an open-
- 11 <u>air vehicle used in connection with a K-9 law enforcement</u>
- 12 program.
- 13 (d) Definitions.--As used in this section, the term "law"
- 14 enforcement agency" means a police department or organization of
- 15 the Commonwealth or political subdivision of the Commonwealth
- 16 whose members are empowered to effect an arrest with or without
- 17 warrant and who are authorized to carry a firearm in the
- 18 performance of those members' duties.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
