AN ACT

Amending Title 8 (Boroughs and Incorporated Towns) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers and duties of 2 elected officials, further providing for powers of council 3 and providing for waiver. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 1005(1) of Title 8 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 1005. Powers of council. 9 10 The council shall have power: 11 To, by motion, ordinance or resolution, create the 12 offices of and appoint a treasurer, a secretary, a solicitor, 13 [an engineer,] a street commissioner and other officers as it 14 deems necessary. Subject to section 1005.1 (relating to 15 waiver), the council shall also appoint, through a 16 competitive bid process, and determine the compensation of at 17 <u>least two engineers</u>. The treasurer and the secretary shall 18 not be members of council. A bank or bank and trust company 19 may be appointed as treasurer. All officers and employees

- appointed by the council, with the exception of those who
- 2 under this part or any other act are under civil service or
- 3 have a definite term of office, shall serve for an indefinite
- 4 term at the pleasure of the council.

- 6 Section 2. Title 8 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 <u>§ 1005.1.</u> Waiver.
- 8 (a) Waiver of requirement and certification form. -- If the
- 9 <u>council cannot obtain offers from qualified registered civil</u>
- 10 engineers to fulfill the requirement under section 1005(1)
- 11 (relating to powers of council) to appoint at least two
- 12 engineers, the council may be relieved from the requirement by
- 13 completing a certification form, subject to the following:
- 14 (1) The council must complete the certification form
- 15 <u>before the contract with the selected engineer is executed</u>
- and must maintain the form throughout the life of the
- 17 <u>contract with the engineer.</u>
- 18 (2) The certification form must be completed annually.
- 19 (3) A copy of the certification form must be filed with
- the department.
- 21 <u>(4) The department shall furnish the certification form,</u>
- 22 which must:
- 23 (i) Require the council to disclose the methods and
- 24 <u>dates of the public solicitation. For purposes of meeting</u>
- 25 this requirement, the council shall advertise requests
- for proposals and announce the solicitation at a public
- 27 <u>meeting.</u>
- 28 (ii) Require the council to disclose the number of
- 29 qualified bids received to the public solicitation.
- 30 (iii) Contain a statement that the information

1 provided by the council is in compliance with 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to 2 authorities). 3 (iv) Contain a statement that the department does 4 not have the discretion to deny waiver requests. 5 6 (b) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 7 8 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 9 "Department." The Department of Labor and Industry of the 10 Commonwealth.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
