## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 2 Statutes, in general provisions relating to operation of vehicles, further providing for drivers of emergency 3 vehicles. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 7 Section 1. Section 3105(d.1) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 3105. Drivers of emergency vehicles. \* \* \* 10 (d.1) Vehicles owned and operated by a county correctional 11 institution [in a city of the first class]. -- The driver of a 12 vehicle that is owned and operated by a county correctional 13 14 institution [in a city of the first class] and used to respond 15 to an emergency at a correctional institution [in a city of the

first class or to escort an ambulance which is transporting a

sick or injured prisoner [in a city of the first class] shall

- 1 comply with maximum speed limits, red signal indications and
- 2 stop signs. After ascertaining that the vehicle will be given
- 3 the right-of-way, the driver may proceed through a red signal
- 4 indication or stop sign.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
